Noah Webster Schools' Distance Learning Program

Noah Webster Schools' Distance Learning Program (NWSDLP) will include a comprehensive on-line model with instruction in core subject areas including lessons, assignments, homework, assessments and grades, along with daily attendance requirements. Please understand, this on-line program is drastically different from the remote learning offered in Spring 2020. Assessments and assignments will be graded and impact promotion and retention for the following year. Students may choose to transition to in-person learning at semester break.

Language Arts	60 to 75 minutes daily
Math	45 to 60 minutes daily
Social Studies	30 to 45 minutes daily
Science	30 to 45 minutes daily
Other (Art, Music)	30 to 45 minutes, 2 to 3 times a week

All students participating in the Distance Learning Program, must have a Learning Coach at home with them throughout the school day. A Learning Coach is a parent, family member, or other adult who is at home with the student.

The role of the Learning Coach is to:

- Guide the student through the lessons, tools, and activities as needed
- Oversee assignments and help facilitate hands on learning
- · Check for understanding and discuss concepts being taught
- Keep the student on schedule and on pace
- Ensure all components are done with fidelity (Independent reading, novel studies, practice activities, etc.)

Here is the expected structure for online learning in the home environment:

student learned, what goals were met, set goals	
for next day.)
