An emergency public meeting of the Board of Directors (the "Board") of the Noah Webster Schools-Pima, an Arizona non-profit corporation (the "Corporation" or the "School"), was held in the Noah Webster Schools-Pima Music Room at 5399 N. Pima Rd, Scottsdale, Arizona at 4:30 pm. A quorum being present, and the meeting having been duly noticed and called, the meeting was called to order.

1. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order.

Approve the minutes of the June 24, 2020 meeting

With no changes or corrections to the minutes of the previous meeting, Director R. Miller made a motion to approve the minutes as presented.

4. Review and Approve the Plan for Reopening School for the 20-21 School Year

The Board had been provided with updated Draft Plan Documents outlining different opening scenarios including a detailed Distance Learning Attachment. Jessica Friedermann explained that with the newly released information from the Governor's office, the school's management team has amended the plan to allow for more flexibility with both plan options. With the information provided we are currently saying that the school could be ready for both a 5-day on-site program and a 5-day on-line program with the necessary preparation that is being required by the State. With the possibility of on-line numbers growing or all students on-line at the beginning of the school year, an offsite, purchased distance learning program was no longer an option. The updated plan provides training for all teachers to become proficient with on-line instructions for opening day if needed.

The Board had several questions and discussions took place regarding the Re-opening Plan and the Distance Learning Attachment.

A motion was duly made by Director Pennington to approve the Re-Opening Plan as presented and discussed including the Distance Learning Attachment.

Director S. Miller seconded the motion.

The motion passed unanimously with Directors Pennington, Wales, Tomasson, R. Miller and S. Miller all voting to approve.
