Dear Noah Webster Families,

We are writing to formally inform you of an important transition affecting our school. At the conclusion of this school year, Noah Webster Schools-Mesa charter school will come to an end. Beginning next school year, the school will reopen in its same location but as Academy of Math and Science – Power, under the charter and management of the Academies of Math and Science (AMS) network. In the immediate future AMS will provide information about enrollment, staffing, school programs, and opportunities to connect with the AMS team.

We recognize that this news may come with uncertainty and mixed emotions, especially for families who have invested so much in Noah Webster over the years. We want to acknowledge the dedication of the Noah Webster administration, teachers, and staff who have served Noah's students and families with care and commitment, often through challenging circumstances. Their work has laid a foundation of relationships, traditions, and school pride that continues to shape this community.

AMS approaches this transition with humility, respect, and optimism. They are a public charter school network committed to providing long-term stability, strong leadership, and high-quality educational opportunities for students. Their goal is not to erase the past, but to build thoughtfully on what has come before, bringing renewed resources, clear systems, and a focused plan for academic growth and student success.

As Academy of Math and Science – Power, families can expect:

- A safe, structured, and supportive learning environment
- A rigorous, standards-based academic program with a strong focus on math, science, literacy, and critical thinking
- Ongoing support for teachers and staff through coaching, professional development, and collaboration
- Clear communication, consistent leadership, and a commitment to partnership with families

As they prepare to open, they are committed to listening, learning, and engaging with families, staff, and community members to ensure that this school reflects the needs, strengths, and hopes of the students it serves.
